## Arts in School

I feel we have made great strides in this area: children worked with Kathryn Saunby Art Studio to bring art to life; children in The Hive enjoyed working with the Iveshead Drama teacher and our whole school choir made us proud as they shared their Christmas joy with the residents at Framland followed by the Mayor's Christmas Concert at the Church - they were brilliant. Children in The Hive have also thoroughly enjoyed learning to play the guitar this term and I know many will be sad it has come to an end for now. We have lots of other opportunities for children to enjoy as we move into 2023 and can't wait to share them!

As you know, FOAKS have been working hard to raise as much money as possible to help support an outdoor structure that we can use as a working space, to replace the decked area in the playground. We are indebted to the team at FOAKS for this and we can't wait to get it ordered, built and used! We are currently gaining quotes from a range of companies and are hoping this work can start around the end of Spring. I have just received feedback from Tesco Communities, and I am delighted to inform you that we have been successful in the Tesco Communities Project and have the chance of winning up to £1500! Everyone needs to shop at Tesco from the end of January to March and post the blue token in support of our project! Again, I will send more details out in January. This money will help towards clearing out the pond area to create a Forest School Area.

We have enjoyed getting involved with many wider community aspects this term, including the Wombles who shared their passion of litter picking; a visit from the inclusion officer with Leicestershire Police, who spoke to children in the Hive about making the right choices to keep us all safe; donating foods to the Storehouse to help those in need, especially with the rising
